## Art Through Literacy Camp

June 28-July 2 9am-2pm

We will read a different children's books each day and create an art piece inspired by each story. For example, we will create puppets inspired by the book, *Where the Wild Things Are* and a paper collage using the techniques of the illustrator, Eric Carle.

Each day we will start in the studio warming up with different fun art activities. Then we will explore Washington Park to get some fresh air and inspiration for our afternoon project. If the weather permits, we will eat our lunch in the park and read our story for the day. Then we will head back to the Albany Art Room to create our masterpiece inspired by the book!

## Mosaic Camp

\$200 + \$20 supply fee ages 6 and up

Come create your own mosaic masterpieces! We will explore different ways to create our own mosaic tiles. For example, we will be going into the pottery studio to make our own clay tiles and add color through glazing!

Each day we will start in the studio warming up with different fun art activities. Then we will explore Washington Park to get some fresh air and inspiration for our afternoon project. If the weather permits, we will eat our lunch in the park. The afternoon will conclude with a fun and creative mosaic project!

## Mask Making Camp

August 9-13 9am-2pm

\$200 + \$20 supply fee ages 6 and up

Each mask will be inspired by a different part of the world. For example, we will make a "tribal mask" like some from Africa! We will use clay, cardboard, paper mache' and more to create these masks.

Each day we will start in the studio warming up with different fun art activities. Then we will explore Washington Park to get some fresh air and find materials that can be incorporated into our masks. If the weather permits, we will eat our lunch in the park and start learning about the specific country. We will conclude the afternoon with work on our masks inspired by the day!

## Nature and Recyclables Camp

Why use art materials from a store when you have so many "free" resources around you! Kids will learn how to make art from nature and recycled materials, such as a prints from leaves and beads created from magazines!
