### **Art Excite with Elizabeth Dubben**

#### *Back to Basics*

This session will focus on the techniques and skills needed to draw and interpret realistic forms by rendering geometric objects such as the Cube, Cone, Sphere and Cylinder - both singularly and in relation to one another. Each class will be devoted to learning how to draw from life. Each student will learn the techniques of gesture drawing, contour drawing, line drawing and finally contrast drawing in order to make two-dimensional renderings of these objects. In the end, students will learn how to appropriately observe what is in front of them, accurately measure objects and depict a simple geometric form on paper. This will be the concrete stepping stone in order to create more advanced realistic observational drawings. Each student will finish the session with a complete body of work representing their focus on geometric forms.

### **Active Art with Sarah Jane Holmes**
